**Letter of Confirmation of Key Worker Status in response to Coronavirus - COVID-19.**

Dear Customer/Client

The staff of **GES Group – Grants Electrical Services Limited** work in most, if not all, of the following industries to ensure that they do not suffer from a critical failure to their equipment, which will close all or part of their operation.

Our staff are key approved, electrical and mechanical engineers, service and maintenance engineers together with their management, to ensure that any critical failures that occur to the following Government Key industries and services are minimised. This includes:

**The National Health Service:**

GES ensure that all the industrial systems and apparatus, motors, pumps, fans, compressors, centrifuges, vacuum pumps, power generation and other rotating equipment are kept in good order and if a failure occurs the equipment is repaired or replaced in the shortest possible time, working 24 hours, 7 days a week if necessary.

If workers think they fall within the critical categories below, they should confirm with their employer that, based on their business continuity arrangements, their specific role is necessary for the continuation of these essential public services.*

**Utilities, communication and financial services**

This includes staff needed for essential financial services provision (including but not limited to workers in banks, building societies and financial market infrastructure),

- Oil, gas, electricity and water sectors (including sewerage)
- Information technology and data infrastructure sector and
- Primary industry supplies to continue during the COVID-19 response,
- as well as key staff working in the civil, nuclear, chemicals
- Telecommunications (including but not limited to network operations, field engineering, call centre staff, IT and data infrastructure, 999 and 111 critical services),
- Postal services and delivery, payments providers and waste disposal sectors.

If your school is closed, then please [contact your local authority](#), who will seek to redirect you to a local school in your area that your child, or children, can attend.

We are grateful for the work of teachers and workers in educational settings for continuing to provide for the children of the other critical workers of our country. It is an essential part of our national effort to combat this disease.

## **Transport**

This includes those who will keep the air, water, road and rail passenger and freight transport modes operating during the COVID-19 response, including those working on transport systems through which supply chains pass.

## **Food and other necessary goods**

This includes those involved in food production, processing, distribution, sale and delivery, as well as those essential to the provision of other key goods (for example hygienic and veterinary medicines).

## **Food Production and Pharmaceutical companies:**

GES are a member body of the AEMT (Association of Electrical Mechanical Trades), electrical and mechanical engineers and service and maintenance engineers, together with their management staff, are essential to keep the food production companies operating. They service, maintain, repair and provide critical emergency repairs for industrial systems, pumps, fans, motors and compressors. These operate their freezers, chillers, stirrers, conveyor belts, and refrigerated transport.

## **Manufacturers and Primary Industry Supplies:**

GES service, maintain and repair and emergency repairs for critical failures on: industrial robots, drives, gearboxes, fans, motors, generators, compressors, industrial heating, fire pumps, conveyor systems.
